¹ The business does not own any vehicles and the premises utilised by the business are electrically heated so there are no Scope 1 emissions from burning fuel in company-owned or controlled assets. Whilst there may be fugitive emissions from the cooling system in the business premises, no data was available on this from the landlord.

² This is a partial calculation of emissions from Purchased Goods & Services, for hotel stays only. We will seek to broaden the scope of the emissions included in this category over time.

³ The only upstream transportation which is paid for directly by the business is for the delivery of welfare units to site. This is therefore the only transportation element included here.

⁴ Waste emissions were calculated from the number of skips used multiplied by a density conversion factor for mixed construction and demolition waste (UK Conversion Factors for Waste, SEPA), with the tonnage then multiplied by the UK Government conversion factor for construction waste.

⁵ No physical products or materials are produced so there is minimal downstream transportation.

Emissions reduction targets

The business is committed to achieving Net Zero emissions by 2050 at the latest. We will keep this date under review, bringing it forward if possible as our carbon reduction plans develop. However, as a main contractor we also recognise that we have limited direct control over the vast majority of our footprint, which stems from our sub-contracting.

We will consider setting nearer-term targets for carbon reduction and will pay particularly close attention to the carbon intensity of the business so that any continued growth in the business is as carbon lean as possible.

Carbon Reduction Projects

Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed:

- ➤ The business has an Environmental Management System in place which is accredited to ISO 14001.
- ➤ The business achieved Green Small Business Certification in January 2023, having developed an environmental policy and comprehensive action plan addressing all of the significant environmental impacts of the business.
- > We prioritise the use of local contractors, to reduce travel and transportation distances.
- ➤ We incorporate waste separation on site where possible, and our principal waste management company recycles more than 90% of our site waste.
- > Business travel has been reduced through the use of video-conferencing.
- ➤ We encourage staff use of sustainable transport modes, e.g., through proVision of the Cycle 2 Work scheme.

Planned Carbon Reduction Initiatives

Our environmental action plan commits us to the implementation of further measures which we anticipate will reduce the carbon intensity of the business, such as:

- Implementing more stringent environmental requirements in our procurement processes.
- > Formalising our site management planning to ensure the highest environmental standards on all sites.
- An increased focus on training for staff, including sustainable construction techniques and the environmental aspects of site management.
- Working with our landlord to improve the environmental performance of our premises.
- > Facilitating access to low-emission vehicles for our employees
- > Providing guidance on environmental and carbon management to our staff.
- > Ensuring environmentally responsible purchasing.
